Spring Family Camp Packing List

** Note this list is per person and to be used as a guide, but don't hesitate to bring extra clothing and keep in mind we play outside so don't bring your favourite white blouse!!*

- 2 pairs of pants (at least 1 non-jeans recommended)
- 1-2 pairs of shorts
- 2-3 tee shirts, 1 long sleeve
- Warm Jacket or vest (the nights can still be cool)
- Sturdy close-toed shoes for wearing around site
- A Warm Sweater
- Underwear (per day recommended, hehe) and 3 pairs of socks
- RAIN JACKET (in our experience if you bring it, it wont rain – if you DON'T...it will) & Rain Boots (optional, fun if its wet)
- Slippers or slip on sandals for wearing inside
- Pillow and sleeping bag or bedding** (please be prepared for chilly temperatures – even though the cabins are heated!)
- Toiletries & a WATERBOTTLE ☺
- Flashlight (there is no overhead lighting at RKY camp)
