Winter Family Camp Packing List

** Note this list is per person and to be used as a guide, but don't hesitate to bring extra clothing as its better to have too MUCH then not enough warm clothes! ☺*

- Warm Winter Jacket & SNOW PANTS!
- Winter Boots !!
- 2 Toques & 2 pairs of winter mittens/gloves (waterproof highly recommended)
- 2 Warm Sweaters (wool/fleece are recommended)
- 2 pairs of long underwear (tops & bottoms)
- Underwears!
- 4 pairs of warm socks (non-cotton highly recommended)
- 1 or 2 pairs of long pants (non-jeans recommended)
- Slippers or slip on sandals for wearing inside
- **Pillow and sleeping bag or bedding** (please be prepared for chilly temperatures – even though the cabins are heated!)
- Toiletries
- Flashlight (there is no overhead lighting at RKY camp)
- Water bottle
