

SUMMER PACKING LIST

The following items are recommended for making your child's stay at camp comfortable and complete. Campers are strongly encouraged to take responsibility for their belongings at all times. Staff will be available to assist in organizing and packing upon return to Kingston, but are not responsible for campers' belongings while at camp. **Please help reduce lost and found by clearly LABELING your child's belongings.**

Camp Clothing & Equipment

- ___ 2 week supply of underwear
- ___ 12+ pairs of socks (some wool)
- ___ 3-4 pairs of shorts
- ___ 3-4 pairs of pants/sweatpants
- ___ 4-8 T-shirts
- ___ 1-2 long-sleeved shirts
- ___ 1-2 sweaters or sweatshirts
- ___ Warm jacket
- ___ Bathing Suit
- ___ Pajamas
- ___ At least 2 pairs of running shoes (preferably old and well broken-in)
- ___ Rain coat or suit is important - test yours in the shower!
- ___ Sun hat or baseball cap & Sunglasses
- ___ Medic alert bracelet/necklace (if applicable)
- ___ Blankets & Sheets **or** sleeping bag (see canoe tripping equipment below)
- ___ Pillow with case
- ___ Toiletries - comb/brush, soap/shampoo, toothbrush (2), toothpaste, etc.
- ___ Two or three towels, washcloth
- ___ Laundry Bag / plastic garbage bag
- ___ Sun Screen
- ___ Insect repellent
- ___ Chapstick
- ___ Flashlight and extra batteries
- ___ Stationary, pen, stamped envelopes
- ___ Rubber boots

Optional Equipment:

- ___ Optional: Books, Magazines, Family Pictures, Sports equipment, Camera, Waterbottles.
- ___ One change of nice clothes for banquet
- ___ Ragger's rag (if previous participants in RKY Rag Program)

Canoe Tripping Equipment:

- ___ Sleeping bag (synthetic fabrics dry faster than cotton and goose down)
- ___ Hiking Boots – hiking boots are most necessary for campers aged 13 and up, due to the length and type of trip

Undesirables: Please don't bring: iPods, money, food, gum or candy, glass containers, expensive items, CD player or other valuables.
