March Break Camp 2023 Suggested Packing List

Winter can be a lot of fun - if you are warm and dry. RKY does have a dryer to warm up wet items, but campers should pack enough clothes and gear for the week. The following list can be used as a guide but remember that it is always better to make sure that your camper has something dry to put on!

Campers will be staying in our insulated cabins – each bed has a camp mattress, but bedding/linens are not provided.

MEDICATIONS (both prescription and over the counter): Should be clearly labelled with instructions and given to the Outdoor Centre Director when dropping your camper off on Monday March 13, 2023.

- -6-7 pairs of heavy socks (wool is best)
- -1 warm and cozy sleeping bag
- -1 pillow and pillowcase
- -2-3 pairs of long underwear/base layer (or layers you can wear under bulkier clothing)
- -3 pairs of pants (not jeans)
- -3 sweaters or sweatshirts (fleece and wool are the best choice)
- -1 pair of snow pants
- -1 warm winter jacket
- -2 winter hats; scarves/neck warmers

- -4-5 T-shirts
- -5 pairs of underwear
- -2 pairs of mitts (waterproof if possible)
- -1 pair of winter/waterproof boots (removable liner is ideal)
- -1 pair of indoor shoes or slippers
- -1 water bottle
- -flashlight (with extra batteries)
- -Personal toiletries toothbrush, toothpaste, comb, shampoo, soap, hygiene products, etc.
- -towel for showering (cabins will alternate shower times every night), flip flops for wearing in the shower
- -**Optional:** camera, musical instrument, journal & pen, books, card games, sunglasses

Please do not bring: Candy, iPods/MP3 Players, hair driers, good clothing, or any personal valuables. Campers are not allowed to have CELL PHONES during RKY March Break Camp.
